DR. DAVID WOODARD, CLEMSON PROFESSOR OF POLITICAL SCIENCE, AUTHOR, POLLSTER, TO SPEAK AT JAN. 24 MEETING

The Greenville County Republican Women's Club is honored to have Dr. David Woodard as our speaker for our January luncheon.

Dr. Woodard is a political scientist who serves as a political consultant for Republican candidates. Successful candidates include the following: Bob Inglis for Congress, 1992; Lindsey Graham for Congress, 1994 and 1996; Jim DeMint for Congress, 1998; Bob Peeler for Lieutenant Governor, 1994; George W. Bush for President, 2000; Gresham Barrett for Congress, 2002; and Jim DeMint for Senate, 2004.

He has been a professor in the political science department at Clemson University since 1983. He teaches political theory, political parties, politics and the cinema, and American government.

Dr. Woodard is the author of several books. His latest book is *Why We Whisper: Losing Our Right to Say It's Wrong*. He co-authored this book with Sen. Jim DeMint. According to the Barnes and Noble website, *Why Whisper?* calls on Americans who believe in traditional values to resist

the urge to stay silent and thus safe under the shameless onslaught of pressure, intimidation, and ridicule from the San Francisco-loving, *NY Times* reading, multicultural, anti-business, French-first, tree-hugging secular progressives and liberal political elites. This book was just published in January and is available at Barnes and Noble.



Dr. Woodard is also the author of *The America That Reagan Built* and *The New Southern Politics* both published in 2006. Along with several other books published before 2006, he has two books under contract that will be going to press in the near future.

He has received many honors including Alumni Master Teacher Award, Golden Key and the Fluor Daniel Award for Excellence in Teaching. He was the first campus faculty inductee to receive the Mortarboard honor.

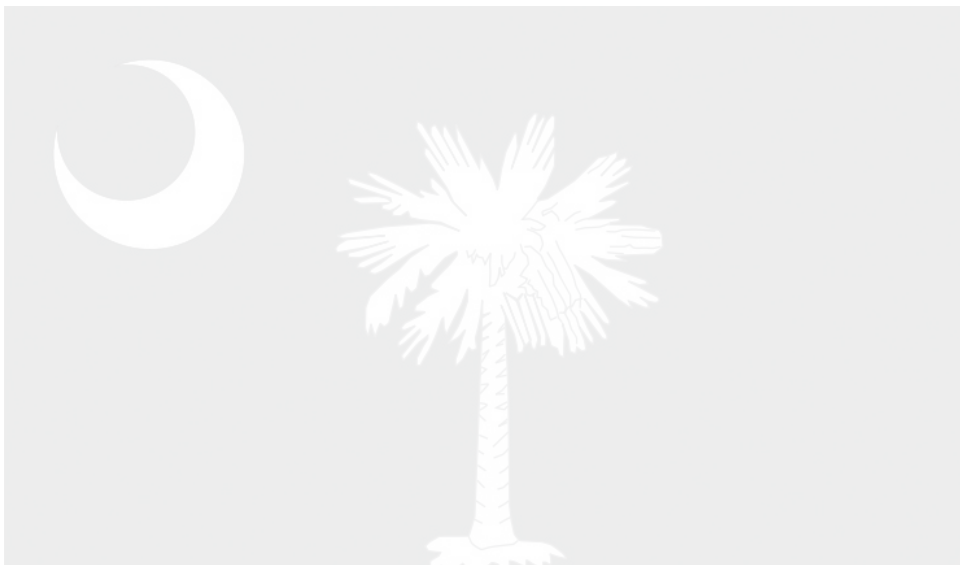

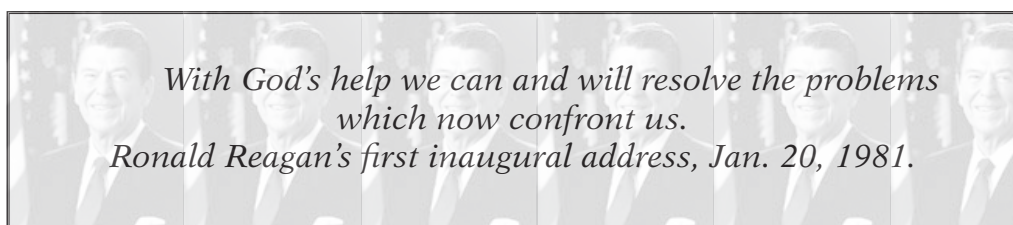
