February Meeting:

Modern-day slavery is alive and well here in our state.

We are honored to have Attorney General Alan Wilson. He will discussing the modern day trafficking and the proposed legislation would give the State Grand Jury authority to investigate human trafficking and provide law enforcement the necessary tools to go after traffickers.

Did you know the girl next door from you could be being trafficked? Did you know that if we have a young person who has been trafficked in several counties that it makes it harder to prosecute them trafficker.

Check on your legislators to be sure they are supporting or co-sponsoring these bills, H. 3125 and S. 196 to give law enforcement the necessary tools to stop human trafficking in South Carolina. Come and hear Attorney General Alan Wilson explain the issues we are having here in South Carolina with this modern slavery. We want these bills passed before February is over.



The Attorney General is one of the state's constitutional officers, and performs many important functions, such as overseeing criminal appeals in state and federal court, and protecting the state's interest in civil matters, such as litigation brought against the state or in class action lawsuits. Alan Wilson is beginning his second term as our Attorney General.

March 16th Precinct Reorganization:

The Greenville County Republican Party will be having precinct elections and precinct reorganization on Monday, March 16th at 7 p.m. at your normal voting place. The elections will last about 90 minutes. The elections determine the party leadership and the values reflected in the party platform. There is NO cost to attend precinct reorganization.

At the precinct meeting, you may run to be a delegate or alternate to the County Convention or to the State Convention. The delegate and sometimes the alternate votes at the County Convention, and if elected can vote at the State Convention. The County Convention is Saturday, April 25, starting at 9 a.m. at the Greenville Shrine Club Auditorium. The State Convention will be Saturday, May 16, in Columbia, South Carolina.

You may also run to be executive committeeman. Executive committeeman attends the monthly county meetings and votes on the county issues. It is a two-year term. They can also be a delegate if they get the majority vote from the other precinct members.

Can you carve into your schedule a couple of hours a month to take our country back? Is your liberty, and your children's, not worth at least that?

Almost half of the Republican Party precinct committeeman slots, nationwide, are unfilled! If true conservatives filled up all the empty slots they OWN the Party. Plan to attend your precinct meeting, raise your hand and take a stand!


