Remember, THERE ARE NO WALK-INS.


If there is an empty seat or two at your table, have someone raise their hand with the number of seats available, so greeters can help seat latecomers.

# **AMERICAN IDENTITY and Sen Scott's book**

Last month, we considered American Identity as opposed to British Identity as we mourned and reviewed the life of Queen Elisabeth, the 2<sup>nd</sup>. 
