
VOLUNTEER HOURS are due in December

It's time to turn in your volunteer hours for the past 6 months. So check your calendar and review the list below for what counts. Then add up your hours and the number of phone calls and bring to our December meeting. We will have clipboards at each table for you to write them down.

Here's a reminder of what counts:

- 1) TIME at all club meetings, board and committee meetings, Republican Conventions, functions, and fundraisers counts.
- 2) **Organizing** any time you spend printing, addressing, stuffing, e-mailing, or filing counts.
- 3) **Travel Time** the time from when you left your house till you arrive counts and the time from when you leave home counts. This includes driving to our monthly meetings.
- 4) **Conducting** any time you spend conducting a training or conducting a committee meeting counts.
- 5) **Training** any time you spend attending a training seminar or committee meeting for the Republican Party or GCRW or SCFRW counts.
- 6) **Planning** any time you spend planning or preparing for a meeting, fundraiser, or rallies.
- 7) **Campaigning** any time you spend block walking, making phone calls, working the polls, volunteering at headquarters, running for office, or volunteering at a candidate's headquarters counts.
- 8) Advocating For Republican Bills or Contacting your representative in the Legislature whether in person, via email or phone.
- 9) **NEW!** Paid political hours as long as it is *NOT your MAIN Source of Income*.

 For example, you may now count time as a paid election official, working for the ballot board, poll watching, or working for a candidate part-time.

Excerpts from Robin Duffie's prayer at the Tim Scott luncheon

Dear Gracious Heavenly Father,

Thank you for this day and the opportunity to gather together. I pray that we will feel your glorious presence in this room today. And that all that is said, will be Your will, not ours.

Lord, We are overwhelmed by the ever present evil, by doublespeak and treachery. We pray without ceasing...but we need 48 hours a day, 24.

Is our Nation irredeemable? America is a great and noble Country, yes imperfect, governed by imperfect people. How do we make America great again? Through elections, more laws? Lord, we believe our Nation needs is a GREAT awakening; where men, women, and children turn their eyes to You and welcome you back into our institutions and traditions. An awakening which will instill the yearning in our hearts that was embodied in the Pilgrims who, on faith, boarded ships and crossed a fierce ocean to arrive in a new land, not for financial gain, or adventure, but for a deep desire to worship you Lord without fear of persecution.
